



THE WEDDING HEIRLOOM

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My goal for this project was to design a wedding dress that would meet my client's desire to make a bold statement. Inspiration for "The Wedding Heirloom" came from fabrics my client selected.

Draping techniques on a fit model were used to develop the wedding dress. After the muslin was constructed of similar fabrics, the dress design was critiqued and modifications were made. The bodice and skirt were constructed and then the lace and bead embellishments were added by hand. A lace and beaded bra completed the look.

The fitted skirt and long train help to create an elegant look when the bride is walking down the aisle. The bodice of this sleeveless wedding dress is accented with lace around the neck, and down the front princess line. The dress is constructed of 100% polyester satin and organza.
