Greg Bailey joined Iowa State University on November 4, 2019, as the new university archivist. Bailey comes to Iowa State from the Cushing Library at Texas A&M University, College Station, where he served as university archivist and Clements Curator for five years. Prior to his time at Texas A&M, Bailey was the university archivist and records manager at Stephen F. Austin State University, Nacogdoches, Texas, for three years.

Jessica Ballard will become the archivist of Multicultural Collections and Services at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign beginning in March.

Daniel Hartwig started October 1, 2019, as the head of Iowa State University Library Special Collections and University Archives. Hartwig was the university archivist at Stanford University, California, from 2010 to 2019, where he led several efforts aimed at enhancing access to the archives, including large-scale digitization projects, community oral history projects, and crowdsourcing projects. From 2006 to 2010, he served as records services archivist at Yale, and, from 2004 to 2006, as archivist and digital projects developer at Ball State University, Muncie, Indiana.

Tim McRoberts became processing archivist at Michigan State University Archives and Historical Collections.

Kathy Marquis was named the Wyoming state archivist. Marquis will lead the Wyoming State Archives after serving as deputy for the past four years and as interim for the past six months. She has worked in a variety of archival institutions and libraries, including the University of Michigan, Harvard University, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, the Minnesota Historical Society, and as public services librarian at the Albany County Public Library in Laramie. She has been active in the Society of American Archivists delivering papers on archival reference and outreach and chairing committees on continuing education, annual conference structure, accessibility in archives, and the status of women in the profession. She was named an SAA Distinguished Fellow in 2015.

Archives and Special Collections at the University of Louisville has welcomed **Cassidy Meurer** as imaging manager. Meurer is a 2019 graduate of UofL, with majors in photography and printmaking and English. For the past year, she interned in the photographic collections at the Filson

Historical Society. She has also held internships at Dieu Donne Papermill and Hound Dog Press, served as a docent at the Speed Museum, and been a floral designer at Nanz & Kraft.

Scott Pitol, CA, has accepted a position as library services solutions architect for Iron Mountain, where he develops custom shifting, moving, and off-site storage and retrieval plans for libraries and archives. Previously, he served as university archivist at the University of Illinois at Chicago and corporate archivist at the Pampered Chef. He also served as Midwest Archives Conference Chicago Local Arrangements Committee Reception Subcommittee chair, Chicago Area Archivists inaugural vice chair and Steering Committee member, and SAA Business Archives Section chair, vice chair, and past chair.

Geoffrey Reynolds's article "Keep 'Em Fighting: Chris-Craft's Contribution to WWII" was honored by the Historical Society of Michigan at its annual meeting with the Best Article in Michigan History Magazine award. It was the July/August 2019 cover story. Reynolds is the Mary Riepma Ross Director of the Joint Archives of Holland at Hope College.
