REPRINTS OF RARE PAPERS ON MOLLUSCA

Malacologists and paleontologists working in our larger institutions are only faintly aware of the difficulties faced by those who do not have a large library in their immediate vicinity. For the convenience of those who are faced with such library problems, STERKIANA is attempting to reprint articles in its field that are difficult of access for one reason or other.

So far, the reprinting program has been confined to defunct publications such as the Canadian Naturalist and Geologist and long-lived periodicals such as the American Journal of Science and the Canadian Field-Naturalist. The editors of both the latter periodicals have been most helpful in granting permission to reproduce material published in the earlier volumes of their journals.

Reprints of papers by D. H. Barnes, J. W. Dawson, Elkanah Billings, and Robert Bell have already appeared in STERKIANA Nos. 6 and 7. The program is continued in this issue (No. 8) with other papers by Barnes, S. P. Hildreth, F. R. Latchford, H. B. Small and P. B. Symes, and Robert Bell.

Separates of these papers are available at cost (half a cent per page) to malacologists and paleontologists from the Editor of STERKIANA.

Readers of this periodical are invited to submit titles of papers in STERKIANA's field which it would be advantageous to reprint. If permission to do so can be obtained, or if the articles are in defunct periodicals, every effort will be made to reproduce them in forthcoming issues of STERKIANA.
